Food consumption	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food Consumption Score (FCS) • Household Dietary Diversity Score (HDDS) 	Integrated Calorie Proxy
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Household Hunger Scale (HHS) • Reduced Adaptation Strategies Index (rCSI) • HEA: Survival Deficit (DS) and Livelihood Protection Deficit (DPME) 	
Evolution of livelihood	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Index of Adaptation Strategies Based on Livelihoods (ISAME) 	

Secondary results

Results	Direct evidence	Indirect evidence
Nutritional Status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prevalence of Global Acute Malnutrition (Weight/Height – WHZ) • Body Mass Index (BMI) 	Perimeter Brachial (PB/MUAC)
Mortality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crude Mortality Rate (CMR) • Under-5 Mortality Rate (TMM5)
